### Summary of Curriculum Vitae

Italian nationality: born in Bologna, October 22, 1948 and resident in Bologna, Italy. He has three specializations: Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology, in the University of Bologna, and Sports Medicine, in the University of Chieti. He also obtained the qualification of Director in Internal Medicine and in Gastroenterology in the early 90s.

During the **academic period** (years '80-'90) has served as Assistant Professor in the University disciplinary group of Internal Medicine. During this time he was elected as Representative of Researchers in the Faculty Council and the Bureau of Medicine and Surgery where, given the expertise, was elected to a number of committees (Schools of Specialization, Relationships between University and NHS, planning of university staff). In the period 1987-1990 has been elected to the Board of Directors of the University of Bologna.

With regard to **clinical activity**, after two decades (1977-1998) at the university as a Resident Physician and as a Confirmed Researcher at the Medical Pathology and Clinical Medicine of the Policlinico S. Orsola University Hospital in Bologna, since 1998 he has been Director of the Internal Medicine Unit A at the Maggiore Hospital of Bologna. From August 2003 to October 2005 he was also the Director of Medical Surgical Department of Gastroenterology and since 2006 he has been Coordinator of Medical Center Area of the Medical Department of the AUSL (local health authority) of Bologna.

The **educational training** activities throughout the academic years was characterized by a number of specialized teachings at the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery at the School of Specializations of the University of Bologna. Later, during the period at the Maggiore Hospital he has taught, as an Adjunct Professor, "Medical Oncology" until 2009, " Functional and Instrumental Semiotics " until 2008, at the University of Bologna. At present, more as a Adjunct Professor, teaches "Gastroenterology (Pathophysiology)", at the School of Specialisation in Gastroenterology, Catholic University of Rome. Since 2010 he has been a Professor at the Master's Degree in Clinical Ultrasonography, University La Sapienza of Rome. Since 1998 he has been the Director of Research and Training Centre and Clinical, Vascular and Interventional Ultrasonography of the Maggiore Hospitals of Bologna.

The most interesting areas of **scientific activity** were focused on clinical fields (studies of gastroenterological pathophysiology, inflammatory and neoplastic diseases, internal medicine and interventional ultrasonography) and aspects of health organization (accreditation, local implementation plan of internal medicine of the province of Bologna, management of hospital admissions, hospital overcrowding, organization of hospitals for intensive care). He is currently a member of the Observatory on Regional Specialization Schools of Medicine in Emilia Romagna (OSSMER). He was a member of the Executive Council of the Italian Society for Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology (SIUMB). He is a member of the Executive Council of the Italian Society of Internal Medicine (SIMI) and the Scientific Committee of MED3 (provider of distance learning). He is Web-site Editor of two scientific societies: SIUMB and SIMI. The most recent publications have focused on the use of lasers in the treatment of hepatocellular carcinoma and the definition of the National Institute of Health Guidelines on the diagnosis of liver tumors.

He has been a Speaker, a Professor and Chairman, at various conferences and training courses and has authored over 700 publications and scientific reports. The most relevant scientific publications are listed in PubMed and can be viewed at:
